## **Can I get credit?**

Professional musicians from the service bands and Dr. Randall Eyles, Camp Director.

## **On Campus**

All students should enter campus from the lower parking lot through the entrance atop of the circle drive/drop-off. Student entrance will be towards the left nearest the chapel, the summer school staff will be onsite to open the door and direct any students that cannot find their classroom. When students are on campus they are permitted to bring a snack with them and store in their classroom and vending machines will be available in the cafeteria. Students are not to leave the ground floor where all summer classes will be held without permission. All students taking summer courses or workshops should arrive in “dress down” attire, any students wearing clothing that is not in line with Bishop Ireton High School dress code (dress down) policy will be asked to have a parent/guardian bring proper attire.

## **Attendance**

The courses are taught at an expedited pace, so class attendance is essential to success in the course. Good attendance contributes directly to success; therefore, students are expected to attend all classes every day. This is essential as it keeps the student up to speed on what is being taught and does not delay the instructor with a student that is behind in the material. If a student needs to be absent, they should pre-arrange with the instructor.

## **Tuition**

- If a student decides he/she is unable to attend class before class begins the tuition **less \$50.00 will be refunded.**
- Students who withdraw from school within three class days will have **one-half of the tuition refunded.**
- Students who withdraw from school after three class days are responsible for **full payment of tuition.**
